Brasil@Rice Collaborative Travel Grant For RICE FACULTY going to Brazil

Grant Application Process

In line with Rice University's commitment to promoting meaningful academic interactions with Brazilian universities and research institutions through collaborative research and academic exchange. The Brasil@Rice Office is offering a limited number <u>of travel awards for Rice tenured</u> <u>and tenure-track faculty interested in identifying and/or meeting with existing collaborators from</u> <u>Brazilian universities and/or research institutions</u>. These awards are intended to: 1) enhance existing research and academic partnerships and/or 2) establish new networks of collaboration between Rice and Brazil. Funds for the grants are provided through the Brasil@Rice Office, under the division of the Vice Provost for Academic Affairs.

The maximum amount that can be requested is \$5,000. This award is intended only to defray the costs of visiting research partners' travel <u>from Houston to Brazil</u> and/or hotel accommodations, to be applied in conjunction with a cost-sharing plan from a Brazilian Institution (for meals and lodging). No retroactive funding will be awarded.

Here are the steps for the application:

- 1) Complete the Brasil@Rice Application form below.
- 2) Submit a letter of support from your department chair, dean, associate dean, or other appropriate university administrator.
- 3) Submit a letter of support from a collaborating Brazilian institution.
- Prepare a general budget summary and justification for grant funding, including information on additional funds that will be used (departmental funding, Brazilian partner funding, housing, etc.)
- 5) Email the completed application form, letters of support, budget summary, and current CV of the visiting researcher as one PDF document to: Fabiana Santos Brazil Programs Administrator, Brasil@Rice Office, <u>fa20@rice.edu</u>

Applications are accepted biannually and will be reviewed within 6-8 weeks of the deadline. **The fall deadline is OCTOBER 23, 2023**
